

Adopt-A-Kilometre of Trail in Transcona

We welcome groups to participate in improving our community by the adoption of a one kilometre segment of a trail in Transcona. Adoptions greatly improve the trails.

The Transcona Trails association created and adopted the Transcona Trail in 2003. We later accepted monitoring responsibility for the Cordite Trail, the Manitoba Lotteries Fitness Trail and Pandora Pathway. The Adopt-A-a Kilometre Program was started in 2014 to help coordinate assistance from other community groups.

Program participants agree to perform cleanups at least 2 times per year to remove litter and debris. Additional cleanups are greatly appreciated.

How does it work? Select one kilometre of the trail your group wants to adopt. Fill out this application form. We will respond quickly to inform you if that segment is available. If it is available, you will be given an adoption certificate. You will be expected to submit a summary report by the end of October yearly about the number of participants and hours volunteered on the trail. Adoptions should be renewed yearly.

How much does it cost? There is no cost to join. There is an optional cost to have an adoption sign placed on the trail.
